YES - She is redeemed

- Evidence: She reaches out to The Misfit, calling him her child.
- Explanation: This act shows compassion beyond herself, symbolizing a
 moment of grace and connection. O'Connor often emphasizes sudden,
 unexpected grace at the point of death.

NO - She is not redeemed

- Evidence: She spends most of the story selfish, manipulative, and judgmental.
- Explanation: Her final gesture may be seen as fear or desperation rather than true grace. Some argue redemption requires a lifetime of faith, not a last-second change.
