Because this is a **creative exercise**, there is no single "correct" answer. However, student responses should demonstrate:

- Accurate Dialogue: Characters' speech should reflect their personalities (e.g., Puck mischievous, Helena insecure, Bottom comical).
- Scene Faithfulness: Events should align with the chosen scene (e.g., Titania must fall for Bottom, not someone else).
- Conflict & Humor: The comic should highlight misunderstandings or magical mix-ups that drive the comedy.
- Sequential Order: Panels should clearly show beginning → middle → climax → resolution.

Example (Scene 2: Titania & Bottom):

- Panel 1: [Forest] Titania sleeping. Oberon says: "Now, Titania shall see with enchanted eyes!"
- Panel 2: Puck gives Bottom a donkey's head. Bottom: "What angel wakes me from my nap?"
- Panel 3: Titania wakes: "Oh, wondrous creature, I love thee!"
- Panel 4: Bottom looks confused but plays along: "Well, if you insist, my queen!"
- Panel 5: Fairies serve Bottom while Titania gazes adoringly.
