- **Differences** How does the tragic love story of *Pyramus and Thisbe* differ from the comedic resolution of the four lovers?
- **Purpose** Why do you think Shakespeare included the comic performance of *Pyramus and Thisbe* inside his play? How does it affect the audience's understanding of love, fate, or foolishness?
- Personal Reflection Which story (the main play or the play within the play) do you think is more powerful, and why?
