Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Students practice selecting the correct article (**a** or **an**) before nouns based on beginning sound, building foundational grammar and sound recognition.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For **younger learners**, read the nouns aloud so they can hear the vowel or consonant sounds clearly.
 - For **more advanced students**, introduce challenge words like "hour," "uniform," and "honor" to test sound vs. spelling rules.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Create **article cards** ("A" and "An") and have students hold up the correct card when you say a noun aloud.
 - Let students **draw one noun** from the word bank and label it with its correct article for display.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to **write a short story** using at least five pairs from the worksheet.
 - Play a quick **speed match game**: say a noun and see who can call out the correct article first.
