Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Students apply their understanding of the **a/an sound rule** in complex sentence contexts, using reading comprehension and grammar reasoning.
- **Differentiation Tips:**

- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn the quiz into a **class trivia game**, giving points for correct answers and explanations.
 - Let students work in pairs to **justify each answer**, explaining why the chosen article fits the sound of the next word.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to **create five new quiz sentences** using both **a** and **an** correctly.
