Teacher's Guide

- For advanced students, include challenge words like "unicorn" (a unicorn) and "hour" (an hour) to highlight sound-based exceptions.

Engagement Ideas:

- Use sound cards and let students stand on either side of the room labeled "a" or "an."
- Turn it into a sorting race where students quickly move word cards into the correct group.

• Extension Activities:

- Have students draw one item from each list and label it with the correct article.
- Ask students to create sentences using their sorted words for extra writing practice.
