Articles in the story:

Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Students will identify the articles **a** and **an** within context, reinforcing their understanding of how articles are used before nouns based on beginning sounds.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For **younger or emerging readers**, read the passage aloud slowly and pause after each article for students to echo or underline.
 - For **more advanced learners**, challenge them to explain why each article was used and to find any tricky examples (like "a old bridge" vs. "an old bridge") to discuss correct usage.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students use **colored pencils** to highlight each article (one color for **a**, another for **an**).
 - Create a **mini mystery theme**: pretend students are "Article Detectives" searching for hidden clues in sentences.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to **rewrite** the story using different nouns while keeping correct article use.
 - Invite them to **write their own short paragraph** with at least five nouns that need **a** or **an**, then trade papers with a classmate for checking.
