

Oops! My Circuits Autocorrected! Answer Key

1. **Sentence:** The knight was very polite when he said good **night** to the king.
Correct word: *knight* → **night**
Context clue: The phrase "said good ... to the king" shows it's about time of day, not a soldier.
2. **Sentence:** I can't **bare** to see another polar **bear** in the zoo today.
Correct word: *bare* → **bear**
Context clue: "Polar" describes an animal; that tells me it's *bear* the animal, not *bare* meaning uncovered.
3. **Sentence:** Please **pair** the red socks with the blue **pear**.
Correct word: *pear* → **pair**
Context clue: Socks come in pairs, not fruit; "red socks" signals *pair*.
4. **Sentence:** We wanted to **sea** the dolphins at the **see** park.
Correct word: first *sea* → **see**, second *see* → **sea**
Context clue: "See the dolphins" means to look; "park" fits with the ocean/sea.
5. **Sentence:** The teacher asked us to **right** a story about our favorite trip.
Correct word: *right* → **write**
Context clue: "A story" is something you *write*, not something *right*.
6. **Sentence:** My mom says to eat my vegetables so I can grow **strong** and **threw**.
Correct word: *threw* → **through**
Context clue: "Grow strong and ..." refers to progress, not tossing something.
7. **Sentence:** The **whole** class cheered when the robot dug a big **hole**.
Correct word: *whole* → **hole**
Context clue: "Dug" tells us it's about digging in the ground, a *hole*.
8. **Sentence:** I wanted to buy a new **pair** of shoes, but the store didn't have my **pear**.
Correct word: *pear* → **pair**
Context clue: Shoes come in pairs; *pear* is a fruit.
9. **Sentence:** The cat chased its **tale** until it fell asleep on the rug.
Correct word: *tale* → **tail**
Context clue: Cats have *tails*; *tale* means a story.
10. **Sentence:** Our robot said, "I can't wait to go to the **fare** to ride the Ferris wheel!"
Correct word: *fare* → **fair**
Context clue: "Ferris wheel" belongs at a *fair*; *fare* means payment or ticket cost.
