Swapping Contexts in Roleplay Voices

A roleplay voice can make even ordinary situations sound dramatic, spooky, or silly. In this activity, you'll read short roleplay passages and then **swap the context**: keep the voice, but put it into a totally different situation.



Passage 1 - Samurai Giving Advice: "Honor guides the blade, as patience guides the warrior. Only through discipline may victory be won."

New Context (Make a Sandwich):

Rewrite this as if the samurai is explaining how to prepare a sandwich.

Passage 2 - Vampire Bragging: "The night bends to my will, and mortals tremble as I pass. Power and hunger are mine eternal."

New Context (Asking for Wi-Fi at a café):

Rewrite this so the vampire is requesting the Wi-Fi password.

Passage 3 - Cowboy Narrating: "The sun beat down on the dusty trail, my boots heavy but my spirit steady. Trouble was near, and I knew it."

New Context (Taking a Math Test):

Rewrite this so the cowboy is describing sitting down to solve math problems.
