7. **AI** – Tense drift ("reported" vs. "is continuing"), padded phrasing.
8. **Human** – Correct, colorful idiom ("over the moon"), vivid detail.
9. **AI** – Overly polite/formal register, "happy to assist," stiff tone.
10. **Human** – Awkward transition misuse ("on the other hand"), common in rushed speech/writing.
