

Privacy in the Picture Answer Key

1. First Day Vibes - What can be inferred:

The student's **school name**, **location**, and possibly their **grade level or age** (if wearing a uniform or school ID).

Safe or Not Safe to Post: ❌ **Not Safe**

Why: Reveals where the student goes to school, which could make it easier for strangers to identify or locate them.

2. Crowd Pleaser - What can be inferred:

Safe or Not Safe to Post: ⚠️ **Depends / Usually Not Safe**

Why: Large crowds make it seem harmless, but posting while at an identifiable event can reveal your **real-time location**, which isn't safe.

3. Desk Hero - What can be inferred:

Details from the **student's workspace** - possibly their **name on schoolwork**, **school name on digital documents**, or **family photos or home details** in the background.

Safe or Not Safe to Post: ❌ **Not Safe**

Why: Private details in the background can reveal identity or home environment without realizing it.

4. Class Meetup - What can be inferred:

Names and faces of **classmates**, **teacher names**, **school name**, and potentially the **classroom number or decorations** that identify the location.

Safe or Not Safe to Post: ❌ **Not Safe**

Why: Sharing others' faces or school details online violates their privacy and can expose the school environment.

5. Live in Concert - What can be inferred:

The **venue location**, **event date/time**, and possibly **ticket details** (like a barcode or seat number).

Safe or Not Safe to Post: ⚠️ **Usually Not Safe**

Why: Reveals where you are in real time and could expose scannable information (like barcodes or QR codes) that can be misused.
