- 1. "I'm tall when I'm young, and I'm short when I'm old."
  - Correct Answer: Candle.
  - Best Solver: AI (pattern and logic).
- 2. "What has a face and two hands but no arms or legs?"
  - Correct Answer: A clock.
  - Best Solver: AI (logic and clear riddle structure).
- **3.** "What gets wetter the more it dries?"
  - Correct Answer: A towel.
  - Best Solver: **Human** (relies on a playful twist in meaning).
- 4. "Why can't a nose be 12 inches long?"
  - Correct Answer: Because then it would be a foot!
  - Best Solver: **Human** (pun/wordplay).
- 5. "I'm always in front of you but can't be seen."
  - Correct Answer: The future.
  - Best Solver: AI (abstract, logical).
- 6. "Why did the computer go to the doctor?"
  - Correct Answer: Because it caught a virus!
  - Best Solver: **Human** (humor and double meaning).

## **Teacher Notes:**

- Emphasize that some riddles are **logic puzzles** (great for AI), while others are **wordplay or jokes** (better for humans).
- Students should notice that AI can miss humor but is strong at patterns and reasoning.
- Encourage them to come up with their own examples of riddles that would stump an AI vs. a human.
