

Error Correction Challenge Answer Key

Passage 1 Errors

- “goed” → went
- “seen” → saw
- “flied” → flew
- “sayed” → said
- “walk” → walked
- “eat” → ate
- Logic issue: dinner at 2 a.m.

Corrected Version (sample):

Yesterday I went to the park with my friend. We saw two dogs chase a ball, but then one of the dogs flew over the fence! My friend said, “That dog is a superhero!” Then we walked back home and ate dinner together at 6 o’clock in the evening.

Passage 2 Errors

- “sun rise in the west” → sun rises in the east
- “beautifull” → beautiful
- “taked” → took
- “photo’s” → photos
- “drinked” → drank
- “write” → wrote
- “say” → said
- Logic issue: sister called it “sunset” but it was morning

Corrected Version (sample):

The sun rose in the east yesterday and it was very beautiful. I took many photos of the sky. Then I drank hot chocolate and wrote a poem about the day. My sister said, “This is the best sunrise ever,” because it was morning.

Teacher Notes

Passage 1: mostly grammar + one logic issue.

Passage 2: mix of grammar, spelling, and logic contradictions.

Emphasize: AI often slips into **rule-breaking grammar** or **silly logic errors**. Humans are more likely to make **typos** or forget details, but less likely to claim “the sun rises in the west.”
