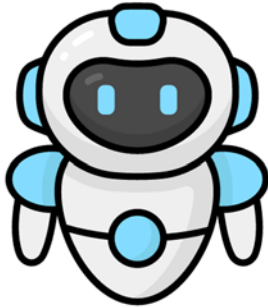

## Dilemmas Through Lewis's Lens



**Instructions:** C.S. Lewis warned against moral relativism and the loss of objective values in *The Abolition of Man*. Below are three present-day ethical dilemmas. For each one, write a short response in which you explain the dilemma. Imagine how Lewis might respond based on his arguments in *The Abolition of Man*. Then, give your own reflection on whether you agree with his likely response.

1. Should AI be allowed to make decisions in areas like hiring, justice, or healthcare, even if it lacks moral reasoning?

2. Should parents be able to genetically engineer children for intelligence, beauty, or talents?

3. Should schools teach that morality is subjective ("my truth" vs. "your truth"), or should they teach universal principles of right and wrong?

4. Of the three dilemmas above, which do you think Lewis would find most urgent today? Why?
