

Personal Reflections on the Tao Answer Key

(Sample Guidance)

Since journals are personal, responses will vary. Below are **sample insights** showing the type of thinking expected.

1. **Sample Response:** "Men without chests" = people without trained moral sentiments. A student might say schools focus on test scores but not on character, which connects to Lewis's concern.
2. **Sample Response:** Many will argue honesty and justice are universal because every society depends on trust. Others may argue morality can shift, e.g., changing views on social issues. Both are acceptable if reasoned.
3. **Sample Response:** A student might recall standing up for fairness in sports or friendships, showing how a larger principle guided them.
4. **Sample Response:** Examples might include AI influencing human decisions, genetic engineering, or social media algorithms manipulating behavior; illustrating Lewis's warning.
5. **Sample Response:** Students may name values like kindness, integrity, or family loyalty; showing a desire to hold to principles even when culture shifts.
