Sample Sentences:

1. **NASA** – NASA built a rocket to send astronauts to the Moon.
2. **GPS** – We used the GPS on my mom's phone to find the fastest route to the zoo.
3. **DVD** – I watched my favorite superhero movie on DVD last night.
4. **FBI** – The FBI solved a mystery by following important clues.

Teacher's Guide

Differentiation Ideas:

- **Younger students (Grades 3–4):** Provide acronym meanings first and have them fill in the acronym in their sentence.
- **Older students (Grades 5–6):** Have them add two or more acronyms in one creative paragraph.

Engagement and Extension:

- Use a **poster project** where students draw and label real-life acronyms (e.g., Wi-Fi sign, NASA logo).
- Connect to STEM by finding acronyms used in science or technology (like **AI, HTML, CPU**).
