Instructions: Below is a list of **major Civil War events** and **key story moments** from *Across Five Aprils*. They are all scrambled out of order. Your task is to place them in the correct sequence to build a timeline

that connects history with Jethro's personal journey. Write the correct **number** order (1-12) in the blank next to each event.

A. The Battle of Fort Sumter ignites the Civil War.
B. Jethro Creighton takes over many responsibilities on the family farm.
C. President Lincoln delivers the Gettysburg Address.
D. Bill, Jethro's beloved brother, decides to fight for the Confederacy.
E. The Battle of Shiloh shocks both sides with heavy casualties.
F. Tom Creighton, Jethro's brother, dies while serving in the Union army.
G. Confederate General Robert E. Lee surrenders to Union General Ulysses S.
Grant at Appomattox Court House.
H. Jethro begins reading newspapers closely to follow war news.
I. President Abraham Lincoln is assassinated.
J. Shadrach Yale, Jethro's teacher, returns wounded from war but eventually
recovers.
K. The Emancipation Proclamation is issued by President Lincoln.
L. Jethro reflects on how the war has changed him and the nation forever.

Extension Activity: On the back, sketch a **double timeline**: one row for *Historical Civil War Events* and another row for *Creighton Family Events*. Place the moments side by side to see how the personal and national stories overlap.
