(Sample Responses)

1. Bill's Decision

- Justified: Yes, because he followed his conscience even though it hurt his family.
- Not Justified: No, because it divided his family during a time they needed unity.
- Evidence: Bill tells Jethro he cannot fight for something he doesn't believe in.

2. Shadrach Yale's Choice

- Justified: Yes, he believed in the Union cause and felt it was his duty.

3. Jethro's Responsibility

4. Neighbors' Actions

- Not Justified: No, punishing the whole family for Bill's choice was unfair.
- Evidence: The Creightons are harassed even though they remained loyal to the Union.
