(Sample Responses)

Jethro Creighton

- Trait: **Responsible** | Evidence: He takes on farm duties after his father falls ill. | Explanation: Jethro grows into maturity by handling responsibilities beyond his years.
- Trait: **Curious** | Evidence: He avidly reads newspapers to follow the war. | Explanation: His hunger for knowledge shows intellectual growth.

Ellen Creighton

- Trait: **Nurturing** | Evidence: She comforts her children during times of fear and loss. | Explanation: Her care holds the family together during hardship.
- Trait: **Faithful** | Evidence: She relies on prayer during uncertain times. | Explanation: Her belief gives strength to the family.

Matthew Creighton

- Trait: **Wise** | Evidence: He counsels his children to think carefully before judging others. | Explanation: His guidance helps shape Jethro's understanding of fairness.
- Trait: **Respected** | Evidence: Neighbors look to him for advice and leadership. | Explanation: His reputation is built on integrity and steadiness.
