## Voice Flip Questions Answer Key

### Sample Conversions:

1. Passive: *By whom was this famous novel written?*
2. Active: *Did the janitor leave the door open?*
3. Passive: *When will the winner be announced by the committee?*
4. Active: *Have the students completed the project?*
5. Passive: *Was the test graded by the teacher yesterday?*
6. Active: *Is the choir singing the song right now?*
7. Passive: *By whom was the mural painted on the wall?*
8. Active: *Will Mr. Smith collect the homework tomorrow?*
9. Passive: *Was the old bridge damaged by the storm?*
10. Active: *Have the detectives solved the mystery?*

### Teacher Notes:

- This activity challenges students to adjust **word order** in questions; especially tricky in passive voice (e.g., "By whom was...").
- Highlight the importance of auxiliary verbs (*is/was/has/will*) when flipping voice in questions.
- Encourage students to compare the **tone**: Active questions sound more direct, while passive questions often sound more formal or impersonal.
- Extension: Have students create a **mini-interview** with 5 questions in active and 5 in passive voice.
