Teacher's Guide

Differentiation Tips:

- Provide cue cards labeled "formal," "friendly," "sarcastic," and "casual" for students to hold up as responses.

Engagement Ideas:

- Have pairs read sentences aloud, switching tones to see how meaning changes.
- Discuss how tone affects how others feel and respond in social situations.

Extension Ideas:

- Challenge students to write two new sentences that would fit both a **formal** and **casual** setting.
