Teacher's Guide

Skill Focus: Builds understanding of how to make respectful, thoughtful behavior choices by interpreting **social context, tone, and emotional control** in real-life settings.

Differentiation Tips:

- Read each scenario aloud and model tone of voice options for students to analyze.
- Offer visuals (e.g., classroom, lunchroom, playground) for context support.
- Allow group discussions before answering to reinforce peer modeling of responses.

Engagement Ideas:

- Have students vote on the best behavior choice and explain why.
- Role-play two versions of each scenario: one wrong and one right. Discuss differences in tone and outcomes.

Extension Ideas:

- Encourage students to write one new scenario from their own experience with two possible endings (positive and negative).
- Create a "Good Choice Challenge" chart where students track real-life examples of self-control and respectful tone during the week.
