Teacher's Guide

Skill Focus: Helps students learn to adapt manners and behavior to different school settings through sorting and verbal reasoning.

Differentiation Tips:

- For nonreaders, provide picture cards of settings and behaviors.
- Model examples aloud before students respond independently.
- Pair students for peer modeling ("Show what you'd do in the cafeteria").

Engagement Ideas:

- Act out behaviors for classmates to guess the correct setting.
- Use real-life visuals of the school cafeteria, classroom, and gym.

Extension Ideas:

- Add new settings like playground or hallway.
- Have students draw one example of good behavior for each setting.
