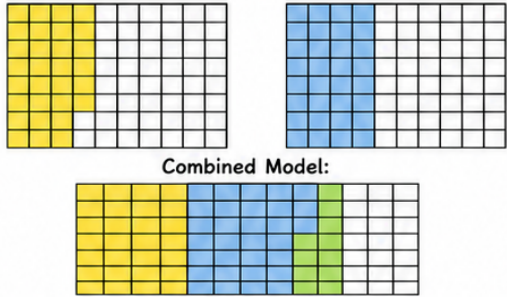
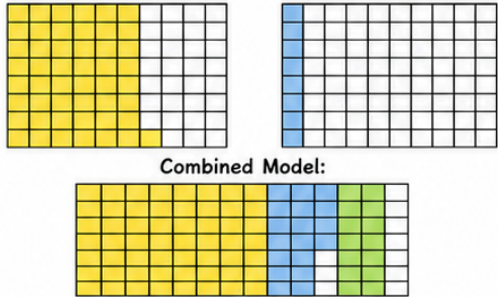
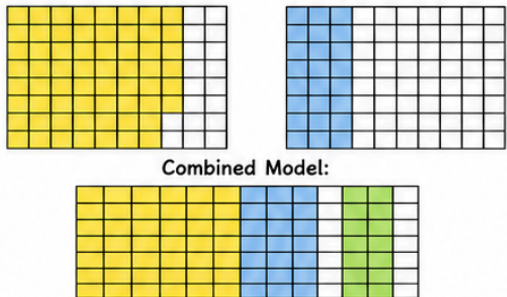
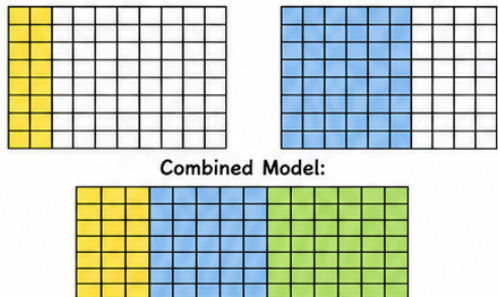
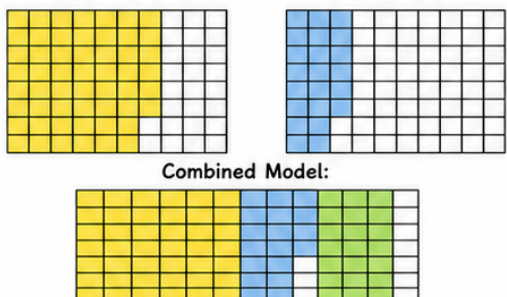
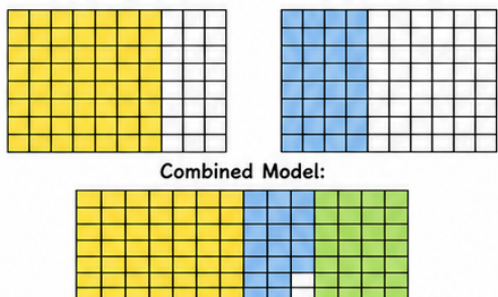


Decimal Models Answer Key

1. Model A: 0.24 Model B: 0.35  Equation: $0.24 + 0.35 = 0.59$ Sum: <u>0.59</u>	2. Model A: 0.41 Model B: 0.18  Equation: $0.41 + 0.18 = 0.59$ Sum: <u>0.59</u>
3. Model A: 0.56 Model B: 0.22  Equation: $0.56 + 0.22 = 0.78$ Sum: <u>0.78</u>	4. Model A: 0.13 Model B: 0.47  Equation: $0.13 + 0.47 = 0.60$ Sum: <u>0.60</u>
5. Model A: 0.39 Model B: 0.16  Equation: $0.39 + 0.16 = 0.55$ Sum: <u>0.55</u>	6. Model A: 0.52 Model B: 0.27  Equation: $0.52 + 0.27 = 0.79$ Sum: <u>0.79</u>

Note: Each hundred grid represents 1 whole. Each small square is 0.01 (one hundredth).

Teacher's Guide: Review that one whole is represented by 100 small squares, so each square equals one hundredth. Encourage students to shade one decimal in one color and the second decimal in another color before combining them.
