Teacher's Guide

- Review that the denominators stay the same when adding fractions with like denominators.
- Encourage students to think, "What numerator is missing?" by subtracting the known numerator from the total numerator.
- Allow students to use fraction strips or counters if they need visual support.
- Pair students to explain how they found each missing fraction before checking answers.
- Challenge early finishers to simplify any answers that can be reduced and explain why the equation is still correct.
- Extend the activity by having students write three missing addend fraction equations for a partner to solve.
