3. False. Correct equation: $\frac{3}{6} + \frac{2}{6} = \frac{5}{6}$
4. Less than 1. Exact sum: $\frac{7}{8}$
5. Mistake: The denominators were added. Correct answer: $\frac{4}{5}$
6. B. $\frac{9}{12}$
7. $\frac{5}{7}$
8. Answers will vary. Example: $\frac{3}{9} + \frac{4}{9} = \frac{7}{9}$

Teacher's Guide

- Use this worksheet as a quick review, exit ticket, or formative assessment after teaching addition of like fractions.
- Encourage students to check that denominators stay the same before adding numerators.
- Allow students to use fraction strips or fraction circles if they need visual support on selected problems.
- Ask students to explain one answer to a partner to reinforce mathematical reasoning.
- Review common errors such as adding denominators or forgetting to estimate before solving.
- Extend the lesson by having students create one review question in each format from this worksheet for a classmate to solve.
