Teacher's Guide

- Review that only the numerators are added when the denominators are the same.
- Encourage students to simplify answers whenever possible.
- Provide fraction strips or circles for students who need visual support before solving mentally.
- Challenge early finishers to write two additional like denominator addition problems for a partner to solve.
- Have students compare answers with a partner and explain how they knew whether an answer could be simplified.
- Extend the lesson by asking students to write a word problem that matches one of the fraction equations.
