Jump Ahead Answer Key

1. Land at $\frac{3}{6}$. Sum = $\frac{3}{6}$
2. Land at $\frac{3}{5}$. Sum = $\frac{3}{5}$
3. Land at $\frac{5}{8}$. Sum = $\frac{5}{8}$
4. Land at $\frac{6}{7}$. Sum = $\frac{6}{7}$
5. Land at $\frac{3}{4}$. Sum = $\frac{3}{4}$
6. Land at $\frac{7}{9}$. Sum = $\frac{7}{9}$
7. Land at $\frac{9}{11}$. Sum = $\frac{9}{11}$
8. Land at $\frac{8}{10}$. Sum = $\frac{8}{10}$

Teacher's Guide

- Model the first problem by placing a finger on the starting fraction and counting equal jumps to the right.
- Remind students that each tick mark represents one equal fraction of the whole.
- Allow students who need support to use colored pencils to draw each jump.
- Pair students to explain how they determined the landing point before writing the sum.
- Challenge advanced students to simplify answers when possible and create one additional number line problem for a classmate.
- Extend the activity by having students write the matching addition equation for each number line.
