2. A little crab found 2 shiny shells. Later, it found 5 more. How many shells did the crab find in total?
3. 6 jellyfish were swimming together, and 2 more floated over. How many jellyfish are there now?
4. A dolphin jumped out of the water 3 times, and then jumped 4 more times. How many jumps did the dolphin make in total?
5. There were 1 octopus in a cave and 6 more octopuses swam in. How many octopuses are in the cave now?
6. A seahorse swam past 5 bubbles, then saw 3 more. How many bubbles did the seahorse see?
7. A scuba diver saw 4 clownfish, then spotted 4 more hiding in coral. How many clownfish did the diver see in total?
8. There were 2 sea turtles swimming near the reef. Then 6 more turtles joined them. How many turtles are there now?
9. A group of 7 minnows swam by, and 1 more fish joined them. How many fish are swimming together now?
10. 3 treasure chests were found by the mermaids, and then they found 2 more. How many treasure chests did they find in all?
11. A pufferfish blew 1 bubble, then blew 7 more. How many bubbles did the pufferfish blow?
12. There were 5 sand dollars on the ocean floor. A wave rolled in 2 more. How many sand dollars are there now?
