Pirates and Treasure Maps - Triple Digit Addition (with regrouping)



1. Captain Coral found 268 gold coins buried on Skull Island. Later, her crew uncovered 457 more coins near the lagoon. How many gold coins did they find in total?
2. Pirate Pete marked 386 steps on his treasure map leading to a buried chest. Then he drew 249 more steps to show the path back to the ship. How many steps did Pete draw in total?
3. First Mate Molly counted 473 rubies in the treasure cave. After opening another chest, she found 268 more. How many rubies does she have now?
4. The Sea Serpent crew collected 529 pieces of silver from one wreck. They found 384 more pieces at another site. How many pieces of silver did they collect in total?
5. On their voyage, the pirates traveled 645 miles to Coconut Island and then 278 more miles to reach the Isle of Shadows. How far did they travel in all?
6. Pirate Jack's journal showed 347 buried treasures found in the Eastern Seas and 268 more in the Western Seas. How many treasures did he record?
7. The Black Parrot ship had 726 cannonballs stored in the lower deck. The crew added 158 more after visiting a fort. How many cannonballs do they have now?
8. A treasure chest contained 489 emeralds. Another chest had 637 emeralds. How many emeralds were there altogether?
9. The pirates rescued 524 parrots from an island. Then they saved 368 more from another island. How many parrots did they rescue in total?
10. Captain Ruby gave 273 gold coins to her crew and then found another stash of 689 coins. How many gold coins does she have in total?
11. The map showed 416 paces to the ancient palm tree. Then the directions said to walk 289 more paces to the hidden cave. How many paces in total?
12. The pirate ship carried 582 barrels of water. After raiding a nearby island, they collected 436 more. How many barrels do they have now?
