
My Community - Join Problems (Change-Increase Situations)

- 5. The grocery store had 46 apples in the bin. A worker added 38 more apples. How many apples are there now?
- 6. During the community clean-up, 9 people started picking up trash at the park. Then 6 more joined them. How many people are cleaning now?
- 7. In the town hall meeting, 28 chairs were set up. Later, 17 more chairs were added for guests. How many chairs are set up now?
- 8. The animal shelter had 12 dogs in the yard. Then 7 more dogs came outside to play. How many dogs are in the yard now?
- 9. The art center had 33 crayons on a table. A volunteer added 29 more crayons. How many crayons are on the table now?
- 10. During the farmers market, 6 people were buying vegetables at Mr. Lee's stand. Then 8 more people lined up. How many customers are there now?
- 11. The town library hosted a reading circle. 14 kids sat down to listen, and then 12 more kids joined. How many kids are listening to the story?
- 12. At the local soccer field, 21 kids started playing a game. Later, 19 more kids joined in. How many kids are playing soccer now?
