1. Liam saw 7 squirrels near the tent. Some more came out of the trees, and now there are 12 squirrels. How many squirrels came out of the trees?
2. There were some marshmallows in the bag. Noah added 6 more, and now there are 15 marshmallows. How many were in the bag at first?
3. Ella collected 9 pinecones while hiking. Her friend gave her some more, and now she has 14 pinecones. How many did her friend give her?
4. At the campsite, 8 lanterns were glowing. Some more were turned on later, and now there are 13 lanterns glowing. How many lanterns were added?
5. Some sleeping bags were laid out in the tent. Then 4 more were added, and now there are 11 sleeping bags. How many were there at first?
6. Jake saw some birds in a tree. 5 more birds joined them, and now there are 12 birds. How many birds did Jake see at first?
7. Ava brought 6 hiking sticks. Her brother brought some more, and now they have 10 sticks in total. How many sticks did her brother bring?
8. There were 7 logs near the campfire. Some more were added, and now there are 15 logs. How many logs were added?
9. Emma packed some sandwiches for the trail. Her dad added 8 more, and now there are 17 sandwiches. How many did Emma pack?
10. While kayaking, Ben counted 11 ducks swimming in the lake. Some more ducks swam over, and now there are 18. How many ducks swam over?
11. Some kids were roasting marshmallows. 3 more joined them, and now there are 9 kids. How many were roasting at first?
12. There were some fish in the bucket. After catching 7 more, there are now 20 fish in total. How many fish were there at first?
