5. On a trip to Canada, Ava counted 58 maple trees along one trail and 29 more along the next. How many trees did she count?
6. During a train ride through India, Noah took 47 photos before lunch and 36 after. How many photos did he take?
7. In Australia, Olivia found 29 seashells at one beach and 64 more at another. How many seashells did she find?
8. At a street fair in Italy, Lucas tried 48 types of pasta and then sampled 37 desserts. How many food items did he try?
9. While exploring Egypt, Sophia read 59 facts about pyramids and 26 more about mummies. How many facts did she read?
10. On a boat tour in Greece, Ethan saw 34 dolphins and then 58 seagulls. How many animals did he see?
