5. The magician the hat suddenly pulled a rabbit from.
6. I at the museum this morning saw accidentally my teacher.
7. The cat under the table hides always during storms.
8. My grandparents send generously us gifts every holiday.
9. The students after class talk loudly in the hallway.
10. He drives to work carefully every day.
