1. Aeneas	A. Queen of Carthage whose tragic love for the Trojan hero ends in despair.
2. Dido	B. Leader of the Trojans, chosen by fate to found the Roman race.
3. Anchises	C. Fiery Italian warrior, rival of Aeneas, and suitor to the princess Lavinia.
4. Ascanius (Iulus)	D. Wise old Trojan, father of Aeneas, who appears as a guide even after death.
5. Turnus	E. Goddess of love and Aeneas's divine mother, who aids him on his journey.
6. Juno	F. Foretold daughter destined to marry Aeneas, sparking a deadly conflict.
7. Venus	G. God of the sky and king of the gods, who enforces fate's decrees.
8. Lavinia	H. Hostile goddess who resents the Trojans and schemes to block their destiny.
9. Jupiter	I. Young son of Aeneas, symbol of Rome's future generations.
10. Sibyl of Cumae	J. Mysterious prophetess who guides Aeneas into the underworld.
