### Teacher Guide

- This worksheet helps students become familiar with major African bodies of water and their importance to geography.
- For grades 3 to 5, review river, lake, and sea before beginning to build clear understanding of each type of water feature.
- For grades 6 to 8, challenge students to explain how these water bodies influence trade, settlement, climate, and ecosystems.
- Read the clues aloud and emphasize directional words like north or central for students who benefit from hearing the information.
- For engagement, let students mark these water bodies on a blank outline map of Africa.
- For differentiation, provide a shorter list of choices for students who need support, or allow them to use a classroom atlas to locate each feature.
- For extension, have students research one water feature and write a short paragraph on how people depend on it for food, transportation, or daily life.
