Teacher's Guide

- **Purpose:** Builds comprehension through **context clues** and reinforces **exploration geography** by identifying routes, achievements, and explorers through descriptive riddles.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For younger readers, preview each explorer's name with short summaries before starting.
 - For advanced learners, remove the word bank and encourage independent recall.
 - Allow struggling readers to underline key clue words (dates, locations, or outcomes).
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn the riddles into a class "Guess the Explorer" game-read aloud and let students call out answers.
 - Create explorer name cards and have students match them to the correct riddle posted around the classroom.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students write their own explorer riddles for classmates to solve.
 - Ask students to trace each explorer's route on a world map and add a short caption explaining what they achieved.
