Teacher's Guide:

- **Skill Focus:** Teaches students the nuanced difference between **all the time** (used for actions that happen repeatedly or habitually) and **the whole time** (used for one continuous period).
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Review with examples: *She laughs all the time* vs. *She laughed the whole time during the show.*
 - Let struggling learners underline time clues (like "always" or "throughout") before choosing.
- **Engagement Idea:** Read sentences aloud and have students respond verbally in a speed round, calling out *all the time* or *the whole time* quickly.
- **Extension Activity:** Have students write two original sentences for each phrase, one habitual and one continuous, to demonstrate mastery in context.
