Teacher's Guide:

- **Skill Focus:** Helps students identify when to use **all** (for every individual or item in a group) and **whole** (for a single, complete unit).
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For developing readers, read the passage aloud and emphasize how the determiners change the meaning of sentences.
 - For advanced students, ask them to replace *all* and *whole* with other words (like *entire* or *every*) to compare tone and clarity.
- **Engagement Idea:** Have students highlight each use of *all* and *whole* in the passage and discuss why that choice makes sense.
- **Extension Activity:** Ask students to write a short paragraph about another event (like a field trip or school concert) using *all* and *whole* correctly at least three times.
