## Feeling Finder Answer Key

1. lonely - She wants company and feels left out.
2. alone - He is by himself but content.
3. alone - She is by herself but happy.
4. lonely - He misses his friends and feels isolated.
5. alone - She is working alone but feels peaceful.

### Teacher's Guide:

- **Skill Focus:** Builds understanding of how *alone* shows a physical state and *lonely* expresses an emotion.
- **Differentiation Tips:** Use visual cues such as facial expression cards or short dramatizations to help students connect emotions to word choice.
- **Engagement Ideas:** Let pairs read the passages aloud using expressive voices to show how tone changes with feeling.
- **Extension Activities:** Have students write their own 3-sentence mini-story showing a time they felt *alone* but not *lonely*, or *lonely* even in a group.
