Teacher's Guide:

- **Skill Focus:** Builds understanding of how *alone* shows a physical state and *lonely* expresses an emotion.
- **Differentiation Tips:** Use visual cues such as facial expression cards or short dramatizations to help students connect emotions to word choice.
- Engagement Ideas: Let pairs read the passages aloud using expressive voices to show how tone changes with feeling.
