Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**

- Review the subject-verb pattern first: *I-am, he/she/it-is, we/you/they-are.*
- For visual learners, write each subject on a card and each verb on another; have students match pairs physically.
- For students needing extra help, group plural and singular subjects with color cues.

- **Engagement Ideas:**

- Turn the worksheet into a matching race where students compete in pairs to match subjects and verbs the fastest.
- Use a "Grammar Chain" activity: one student says a subject, the next responds with the correct verb.
- Create a class chant for rhythm and memory (e.g., "I am! You are! He is!").

- **Extension Activities:**

- Have students create full sentences using the pairs they matched.
- Encourage writing a mini paragraph about themselves using all three verb forms correctly.
- Ask students to find examples of "am," "is," and "are" in books or class readings and share them aloud.
