Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Review the subject-verb pairs (I-am, he/she/it-is, we/you/they-are) before students begin.
 - For struggling learners, practice orally first with call-and-response ("I say 'I,' you say 'am'").
 - Allow younger students to use gestures for each pronoun (point to self for "am," one person for "is," group for "are").
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn the quiz into a "To Be Bee" spelling bee-style game where students stand and answer quickly.
 - Use mini whiteboards so students can hold up their answers for instant feedback.
 - Play background music and pause it for each question to make the quiz interactive.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students write five new sentences using all three verb forms correctly.
 - Ask them to circle the subject in each sentence to show understanding of agreement.
