### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For struggling learners, read each sentence aloud and emphasize the correct form of the verb.
  - Provide visual sentence cards with pictures to match subjects (I, he, they, etc.) to correct verbs.
  - Offer sentence starters for guided practice (e.g., "I \_\_\_ hungry." "We \_\_\_ playing.").
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Have students act out the sentences after fixing them for kinesthetic learning.
  - Turn it into a "Verb Detective" game where students "find and fix" mistakes around the room.
- **Extension Activities:**
  - Challenge advanced learners to create their own three sentences for each verb form.
  - Add a mini writing task: "Write two sentences about your day using *am*, *is*, and *are* correctly."
