Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Review the pattern chart with students before starting: *I-am, he/she/it-is, we/you/they-are.*
 - For struggling readers, read each sentence aloud and have them repeat the correct form verbally before circling.
 - Offer color coding: highlight singular subjects in one color and plural subjects in another.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn the activity into a "Verb Toss" game: say a subject, and students call out the matching "am," "is," or "are."
 - Use real-life examples from the classroom (e.g., "Who is standing?" "Who are sitting?") for kinesthetic learners.
 - Let students work in pairs to quiz each other using the sentences as prompts.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to write three new sentences of their own using each verb form correctly.
 - Encourage students to underline the subject in each sentence and explain why the chosen verb fits.
 - Turn the worksheet into a short skit by having groups act out sentences they wrote using "am," "is," and "are."
