Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For emerging learners, review subject-verb pairs aloud before beginning (I-am, he/she/it-is, we/you/they-are).
 - Provide sentence cards where students choose from three word options for each blank.
 - Allow oral completion for students who need reading support before writing answers.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn this into a "Verb Treasure Hunt" by hiding strips of sentences around the classroom for students to find and fill in.
 - Let students read their corrected sentences dramatically to reinforce correct verb use in speech.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students create five new sentences of their own using each of the verbs once.
 - Ask students to circle the subject in each sentence to show their understanding of agreement.
 - Encourage a mini "verb concert" where pairs act out sentences with correct verb use in short skits.
