11. Sample answers: Ran farms/businesses, served as nurses/spies, made uniforms, helped on battlefields (e.g., Molly Pitcher).
12. Colonists were taxed by Parliament without having any elected representatives in it. This violated their belief in self-governance.
13. Colonists, dressed as Native Americans, dumped British tea into Boston Harbor to protest the Tea Act. It angered Britain and led to harsh laws (Intolerable Acts).
14. The army suffered through the winter with little food or supplies, but training from von Steuben made them stronger and more disciplined.
15. Sample answers: The colonies became an independent nation (USA), Britain recognized American independence, the war inspired other revolutions, new government systems were developed.
