Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For developing readers, read each sentence aloud and emphasize the context clues that hint at the missing word.
 - For advanced learners, remove the analogy structure and have them infer both pairs from context alone.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn it into a “Word Detective” game: students highlight the context clues that helped them solve each analogy.
 - Have small groups create their own “analogy in context” sentences for classmates to solve.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to explain each analogy in full sentences, describing the connection (e.g., “A pencil is used to write; a paintbrush is used to paint.”).
 - Let students illustrate a few analogies to visualize the relationships.
- **Skill Focus:** Develops **inferencing**, **context clue interpretation**, and **word relationship understanding**, while reinforcing **vocabulary reasoning** through real-world and sentence-based analogies.
