### Teacher's Guide

**Purpose:** Helps Grades 3 to 8 students evaluate factual accuracy about Antarctic geography, climate, wildlife, and human activity.

### Differentiation Tips

- Read the statements aloud for students who benefit from auditory support.
- Offer a word bank with True and False cards for students who need visual prompts.
- Encourage advanced learners to rewrite false statements so they become correct.

### Engagement Ideas

- Begin with a quick discussion asking students what they believe is the most surprising fact about Antarctica.
- Display a globe or map and invite students to locate the Southern Ocean and South Pole before starting.
- Allow partners to debate each statement before writing their answers.

### Extension Activities

- Students create two true statements and two false statements of their own for classmates to solve.
- Have students write a brief explanation for any three statements, describing why they are true or false.
