Teacher's Guide

Differentiation Tips

- Offer visual cues such as verbal descriptions of each feature for emerging learners
- Encourage advanced learners to add one fact about each feature next to their answers.

Engagement Ideas

- Begin with a brief discussion asking students to imagine walking across Antarctica and what landforms they might see.
- Share a set of Antarctic feature photographs without labels and let students guess the names.

Extension Activities

- Assign a short writing task where students explain how one feature changes over time.
- Let students research how icebergs form and track famous iceberg events in history.
